## Pompey Targóne

Architect and goldsmith (Rome 1575 - Milan About 1630). He executed the precious ciborium for the altar of the Sacrament in S. Giovanni in Lateran and the architectural structure of the altar of the Pauline Chapel in S. Maria Maggiore (1611, based on plans by G. Rainaldi and A. Tempesti); he was a military architect of the Pontifical State. He stayed in Flanders and in France, where he worked at the siege of La Rochelle.
