

Cristoforo Greppi

Italian Painter
(17th century)

He was an Italian Mannerist painter, active in Rome at the beginning of the 17th century.

Born in Como, he worked in the year 1600 with Prospero Orsi and Francesco Nappi under the guidance of Cristoforo Roncalli on the decoration of the Palazzo Mattei in Rome: Greppi painted the fresco of the *Brothers of Joseph in Egypt*. In the years 1605-1608 he worked with the same collaborators for various decorations in the Vatican Palaces.

Greppi also worked with Giovanni Battista Ricci on the decoration of the Castellani Chapel of San Francesco a Ripa, also in Rome. He painted the frescoes on the vault of the Albertoni Chapel in the same church.
